General Information



The University

The Open University of Sri Lanka (OUSL) was established in 1980 under the Universities Act No. 16 of 1978 and the OUSL Ordinance No 01 of 1990. It therefore has the same legal and academic status as any other national university in Sri Lanka. The OUSL is the only recognized university in Sri Lanka, where one can pursue higher education solely by distance education techniques in keeping with the philosophy of OPEN & DISTANCE LEARNING (ODL).

The OUSL is an attractive choice of study, especially for those employed. The current student population is around 40,000. The OUSL offers courses/programmes from the Foundation and Certificate levels through Bachelors to Masters and PhD degrees. The structure of study programmes provides opportunities for those who complete one programme to progress up the ladder and further improve their educational qualifications. Education at OUSL is thus a life-long experience.

The OUSL functions through a network of centers spread throughout the island. The Central Campus and the Colombo Regional Centre of the Open University are in Nawala-Colombo and are easily accessible by road and railway.

The academic departments of the University are grouped into Six Faculties: Education, Engineering Technology, Health Sciences, Humanities & Social Sciences, Management Studies and Natural Sciences.

According to the 2022 UI Green Metric World University rankings, The Open University of Sri Lanka has become the 566th World most sustainable University and among Sri Lankan Universities the Open University of Sri Lanka has obtained ranking no. 06.

Faculty of Health Sciences

The Faculty of Health Sciences comprises the Departments of Nursing, Pharmacy, Medical Laboratory Sciences, Basic Sciences, Psychology & Counselling, and Health Education & Research. The administrative and academic head of the faculty is the Dean and each department functions under a Head.

The faculty offers quality distance education programmes leading to Nursing, Pharmacy, Medical Laboratory Sciences, and Psychology Honours Degree qualifications. These programmes aim to develop competent personnel who can assume leadership positions, both in the academic and clinical sectors. We are extremely proud to be a major force in educating the next generation of health and allied health professionals in Sri Lanka.

With the Faculty of Health Sciences, you will have the opportunity to enhance your knowledge and skills, work towards a qualification, and further develop your career with a passion for life-long learning.

Study System

The study system of the OUSL is based on distance learning methodologies. It is different to the conventional study system most of you are familiar with. Regular attendance at the University is not required and is therefore well suited for those of you who are employed or engaged in other commitments. Student learning is facilitated through carefully prepared course material suitable for self-learning. Course material are provided in the electronic format. Course material are supplemented with online learning and audio-visual material. Compulsory practical/work-based training sessions are an integral component of many courses. Student progress in courses is evaluated at different time intervals using a variety of assessment methods such as assignment tests and final examinations.

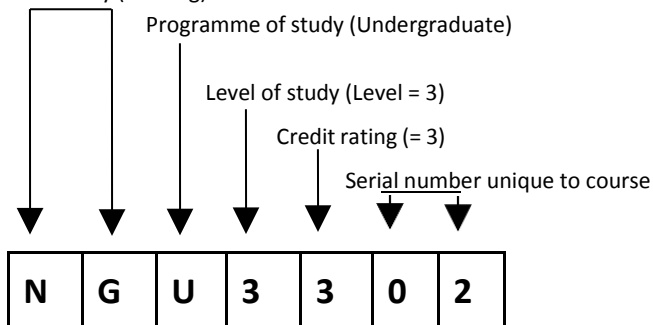
Courses, Course Codes and Credit Rating

The Faculty of Health Sciences offers courses at different Levels. Degree level courses are at Levels 3 (1st year), 4 (2nd year), 5 (3rd year) and 6 (4th year). All courses are offered in the English medium only.

The credit rating is the expression used to denote the 'academic value' of the course/programme. The time you will have to allocate for studying a course depends on its credit rating. The minimum credit rating for courses offered by the Faculty of Health Sciences is 2 credits; such a course will require a minimum allocation of around 100 hours of study time.

Each course offered by the faculty is assigned a course code. A course code will reflect the subject area, level of study and the academic value of the course. In assigning the course code, the programme of study is identified by the letter and level of study is identified by the digit. Incorporating all the above components, each course is assigned a course code consisting of 7 alphanumeric characters as shown in the example of a course code of the Nursing programme.

Support for Learning

Academic Counselling

At the time of registration, you can get advice and guidance from academic staff on selecting courses and other academic matters. In addition, the faculty has five Student Counsellors to help you overcome any general/personal problems.



Recognising the need to promote mental health and well-being of students, the OUSL also offers confidential and professional counselling services to all enrolled students through the Counsellor available at the Counselling Unit located at the Health Care Centre at the Main Campus in Nawala.

Day Schools

Day schools are interactive sessions where you are given an opportunity to meet the academic staff coordinating the course (your course teachers) and discuss problems you may come across in studying your course material. In addition to day schools, we provide face-to-face support through workshops, tutorial sessions and practical classes.

Online Support for Courses

To give you additional help and to get you familiarized with modern learning trends and tools, most courses in the degree programmes are supplemented with an online component. Once you register for a course with an online component, you will be informed and advised on how to access and use it.

Laboratory Facilities

Laboratory facilities are available at the Colombo Central campus, where you can engage in practical work in certain practical based course modules. Computer Laboratory facilities with internet access, are available at the Open University Computer Laboratories located in the Regional Centres and at many Study Centres.

Library Facilities

OUSL library network consists of the main library located at the central campus and regional libraries at other Regional Centres. Libraries have the latest collection of books for reference and lending purposes as well as access to past examination papers. Libraries also provide facilities to view CDs/DVDs and videos relevant to your study programme. You have free internet access including access to valuable e-learning resources.

MyOUSL and Student Email Account

Students registering with the Open University are given access to the MyOUSL web portal and an OUSL email account to provide a speedy communication channel between the student and the OUSL.

Study Leave

Nurses, Pharmacists and MLTs attached to the Ministry of Health and following the BSc Nursing, BPharm and BMLS Honours Degree Programmes, respectively, are entitled to 30 days of study leave per academic year in the Government sector for attending day schools, practicals and for sitting final examinations.

Learner Support Cell

The learner support cell of the FHS provides additional support to the students by facilitating student inquiries through dedicated social media platforms such as WhatsApp and Facebook messenger services. Students can directly contact the LSC (0719655179) and obtain relevant academic information.

The Faculty of Health Sciences offers Four Honours Degree programmes.



1. Bachelor of Science Honours in Nursing [BSc Hons in Nursing]
2. Bachelor of Pharmacy Honours [BPharm Hons]
3. Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Sciences Honours [BMLS Hons]
4. Bachelor of Science Honours in Psychology [BSc Hons in Psychology]

Students who register for any of these honours degree programmes have to complete courses of the degree programme in the different Levels mentioned below.

Level 3 - First year

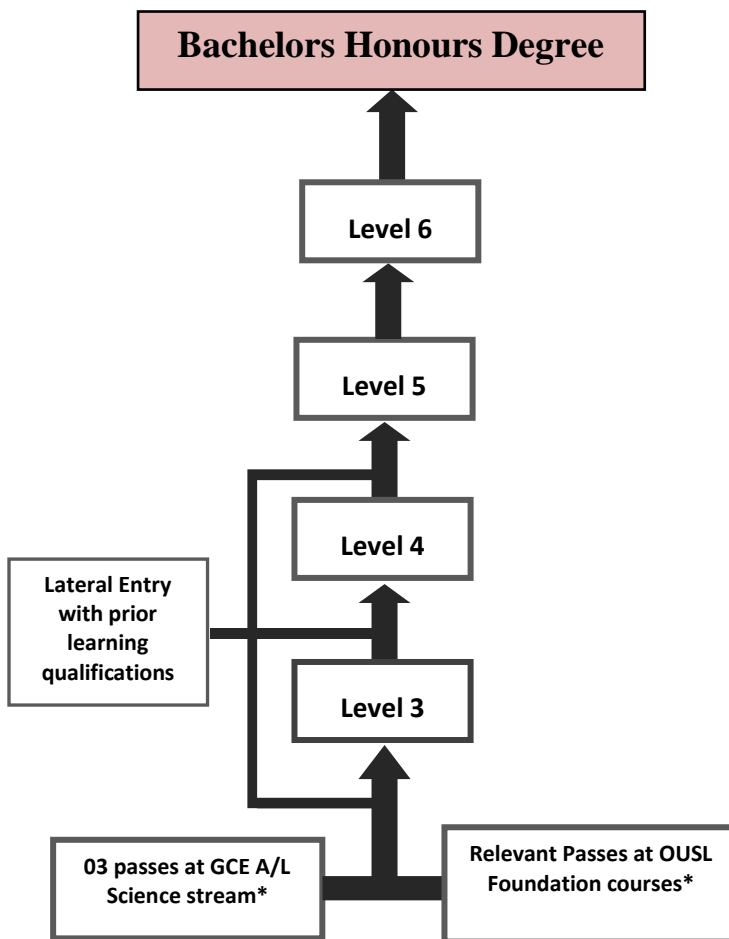

Those having prior qualifications in the relevant field may be eligible to claim exemptions for courses as mentioned under the particular programme.

The OUSL offers a Students Academic Readiness Training programme (StART@OUSL) to all students enrolling for degree programmes to prepare them for distance learning and to facilitate the development of essential language, computer and other skills.

Bachelor of Science Honours in Nursing



The BSc Honours in Nursing Degree programme is offered by the Department of Nursing through the distance mode.

This degree programme was launched in July 1994 as a Post-RN Degree at the request of the Ministry of Health, Sri Lanka as the first ever Nursing degree programme in the country. It was developed with academic assistance of the Athabasca University, Canada and funded by the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA). It is currently offered for nursing professionals in the public and private sectors having the Diploma in Nursing qualification.

Admission Requirements

Applicants should possess the following qualifications to register at the Level 05 of the Bachelor of Science Honours in Nursing Programme.

1. Obtained one of the following:
 - a) Diploma in Nursing or General Certificate in Nursing awarded by the Ministry of Health, Sri Lanka, **or**,
 - b) Diploma in Nursing awarded by the OUSL, **or**,
 - c) Three (03) year Diploma in Nursing awarded by any other institution recognized by the Ministry of Health or any other Government regulatory body in Sri Lanka or any other country with minimum of two (02) years working experience.
- AND**
2. Obtained Minimum three (03) Pass grades in one sitting in the Science stream of study, at the General Certificate of Education (G.C.E.) Advanced Level Examination, Sri Lanka.
- AND**
3. Minimum Simple Pass (S) for English at the G.C.E. Ordinary Level Examination, Sri Lanka.
- OR**
4. An equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Senate
- AND**
5. Pass the Selection Test and be eligible for admission based on the merit list of the selection test marks.

Selection of students

The university selects candidates from among those having the admission requirements, based on their performance at a Selection Test conducted for the purpose of admission. The selection test paper of 01-hour duration will comprise of general knowledge, IQ, English comprehension and questions related to the field of Nursing.

Available places for admission to the BSc Hons Degree in Nursing are filled on the merit order lists of candidates, prepared based on the selection test marks. Each of the nine Regional Centres is first given a minimum quota of 30 places, which are filled based on the Merit List of the respective Regional Centre. The remaining places are filled based on the Overall Merit List. To be eligible for selection on the Overall Merit List or Regional Centre-level Merit List, the candidate must score at least a minimum of 50 marks at the selection test. A candidate can only apply to the Regional Centre (or a Study Centre in the Regional Centre cluster) which is nearest to their place of work or to their permanent residence.

Bachelor of Pharmacy Honours



The BPharm Hons Degree Programme is offered by the Department of Pharmacy. Pharmacy is the profession responsible for the appropriate use of medications, medical devices, and pharmaceutical care services in order to achieve optimal therapeutic outcomes. As such, Pharmacists need to be well-equipped with knowledge, attitudes and skills required to deliver high quality, consistent and safe treatments to their clients. BPharm Hons Degree Programme is designed to develop a professional Pharmacist with knowledge, favourable attitudes and skills in Pharmacy Practice and Pharmaceutical Sciences to suit the needs of the healthcare sector and the relevant academic and research fields.

Admission Requirements

Applicants should possess the following qualifications to register for the Bachelor of Pharmacy Honours Programme.

1. Certificate of Efficiency or Proficiency in Pharmacy, Ministry of Health, Sri Lanka or Diploma in Pharmacy, University of Colombo.
AND
2. Minimum of three (03) Pass grades in one sitting at the G.C.E. A/Level Examination, in the Science stream including a Credit Pass for Chemistry.
AND
3. Minimum Simple Pass (S) for English at the G.C.E. Ordinary Level Examination, Sri Lanka.
OR
4. An equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Senate.
AND
5. Pass the Selection Test and be eligible for admission based on the merit list of the selection test marks.

Exemptions

Students may request specific exemptions from courses based on relevant qualifications they already possess. Application forms for such exemptions can be obtained from the Dean's office of the Faculty of Health Sciences or can be downloaded from the Faculty webpage (<https://ou.ac.lk/fhealth-downloads/>). Duly completed application form together with proof of such qualifications and relevant course descriptions should be forwarded to the Head, Department of Pharmacy on or before **23rd October 2024**. Upon assessment, the student will be informed if the exemption/s could be granted.

For students who possess the qualifications listed in Table 2, exemptions specified are already approved and considered as general exemptions. Therefore, applicants who possess those qualifications NEED NOT to go

through the above process for applying exemptions for level 3 courses separately. The total exemptions which may be granted shall not exceed 60 credits.

Selection of Students

The university selects candidates from among those having the admission requirements based on their performance at a selection test conducted for the purpose of admission. The selection test paper of 01-hour duration will comprise general knowledge, IQ, English comprehension, and Pharmacy related questions. To be eligible for selection, the candidate must score at least a minimum of 50 marks at the selection test. A limited number of students will be selected from among those eligible for selection, based on the merit list.

The BMLS Hons degree programme is offered by the Department of Medical Laboratory Sciences. Medical laboratory services are vital for clinical decisions with respect to disease prevention, diagnosis, treatment and management of diseases. Currently, BMLS Hons Degree programme is offered for Medical Laboratory Technologists (MLT) serving in the public and private sectors. Those interested are invited to take the opportunity provided and enroll in the programme to graduate as a professional equipped with the required theoretical and practical competencies.

Admission Requirements

Applicants should possess the following qualifications to register for the Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Sciences Honours Programme.

1. Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology, Ministry of Health, Sri Lanka.
AND
2. Minimum three (03) Pass grades in one sitting in the Science stream, including Chemistry, at the G.C.E. Advanced Level Examination, Sri Lanka.
AND
3. Minimum Simple Pass (S) for English at the G.C.E. O/Level Examination, Sri Lanka.
OR
4. An equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Senate.
AND
5. Pass the Selection Test and be eligible for admission based on the merit list of the selection test marks.

Exemptions

Students may request for specific exemptions from courses based on relevant qualifications they already possess. Applications for such exemptions can be obtained from the Dean's office of the Faculty of Health Sciences or can be downloaded from the Faculty web page (<https://ou.ac.lk/fhealth-downloads/>) Duly completed application form together with proof of such qualifications and relevant course descriptions should be forwarded to the Head of the Department, Medical Laboratory Sciences **on or before 23rd October 2024**. Upon assessment, the student will be informed if the exemption/s could be granted.

For students who possess the qualifications listed in Table 3, exemptions specified are already approved and considered as general exemptions. Therefore, applicants who possess those qualifications NEED NOT to go through the above process for applying exemptions for level 3 courses separately. The total exemptions which may be granted shall not exceed 60 credits.

Selection of students

The university selects candidates from among those having the admission requirements based on their performance at a selection test conducted for the purpose of admission. The selection test paper of 01-hour duration will comprise of general knowledge, IQ, English comprehension and Medical Laboratory Science related questions. To be eligible for selection, the candidate has to score at least a minimum of 50 marks at the selection test. A limited number of students will be selected from among those eligible for selection based on the merit list.

Bachelor of Science Honours in Psychology



The BSc Honours in Psychology Degree Programme is offered by the Department of Psychology and Counselling. This programme is structured to provide knowledge and basic skills for individuals who have an interest in understanding the discipline of Psychology and its many subfields.

The BSc Hons in Psychology programme will enable students to use theories, models and frameworks of Psychology to explain the human mind, behaviour and experience. To facilitate this, the curriculum includes knowledge on key domains of the discipline (Biological, Developmental, Cognitive, and Social and Individual differences) as well as practical skills on conducting research, ethical standards and issues of professional conduct. The application of Psychological theories employs an evidence-based approach with critical analysis and facilitation of reflective understanding, attitudinal change and personal development planning. The transferable skills such as academic writing, communication skills, project management and self-reflection will also help an individual following this programme to become a more independent and pragmatic lifelong learner.

Admission Requirements

Applicants should possess the following qualifications to register for the Bachelor of Science Honours in Psychology Programme.

1. Obtained a minimum of:
 - a) Three (03) Pass grades in one sitting at the G.C.E. A/Level Examination, in any stream of study, **or**,
 - b) C grades or equivalent in 60 credits (considered equivalent to 3 A/Level passes) from among the Foundation Courses of the OUSL in Science/Social Sciences.

AND

2. Minimum Simple Pass (S) for English at the G.C.E. Ordinary Level Examination, Sri Lanka.

OR

3. An equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Senate.
AND
4. Pass the Selection Test (written) conducted for the purpose of admission.

A student can obtain a BSc Hons Degree in Psychology after completing a minimum of 120 credits at Levels 3-6, together with other requirements. In addition, those who complete 60 course credits of regular courses at Levels 3 and 4 may also apply for the award of the Higher Diploma in Psychology as an interim qualification.

Exemptions

Students may request for specific exemptions from courses based on relevant qualifications they have already obtained. Applications for claiming such exemptions can be obtained from the Dean's office of the Faculty of Health Sciences or can be downloaded from the Faculty webpage (<https://ou.ac.lk/fhealth-downloads/>). Duly completed application form together with proofs of such qualifications and relevant course descriptions should be forwarded to the Head of the Department, Psychology and Counselling on or before 23rd October 2024. Upon assessment on a case-

by-case basis and approval from the Senate, the student will be informed if the exemption/s could be granted. The total exemptions which may be so granted shall not exceed 60 credits.

Selection of Students

The university selects candidates from among those having the admission requirements based on their performance at a computer-based selection test. This includes a 90 minutes written test (general knowledge, reading comprehension & basic writing skills)

- Candidates should obtain a minimum of 50% each for the written test to be eligible for selection.
- Limited number of candidates will be selected on merit basis.

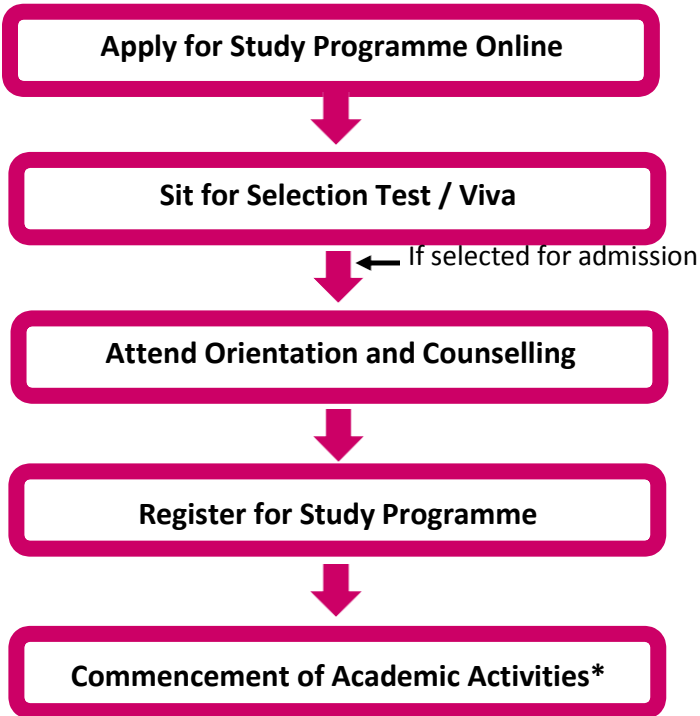

Application and Registration Procedure

To become a student of the OUSL following the degree programme of your choice, you will need to complete/ attend the following main activities.



The above activities are described further in the following sections.

*Note: Academic activities (Day schools, Practicals, etc.) of study programmes will be conducted only at the CRC. Continuous Assessments and Final Examinations of all study programmes will be conducted at all Regional Centres.

Application for Programme of Study

The students are required to **apply online** for all degree programmes offered by the Faculty of Health Sciences. You can fill the online application as per the instructions given in the Appendix 1.

Applications will NOT be accepted after the deadline for the scheduled period of application submission.

Sitting the Selection Test

All four Degree Programmes conduct selection tests (paper-based written test and a viva voce which is only for BSC Psychology degree) for the purpose of admission. When an online application is submitted for the programme, an **admission card** will be generated online. This will include the information about the date, centre and admission number for each candidate. You need to make a printout of this admission card. *If for some reason, this admission card could not be generated, you need to contact the Assistant Director of the relevant OUSL Regional Centre immediately.*

*When you come for the selection test you must produce your NIC and the printed admission card. **Those who do not produce these documents will NOT be permitted to sit the test.** Also, if there are differences in name, NIC no. or other information, you will NOT be permitted to sit the test. **You also CANNOT change the selection test centre, you must sit the test at the centre informed in the admission card.***

The Information on the nature of the written selection test is informed under each programme of study.

For BSc Hons Psychology degree only, in addition to the written test, students are required to face an oral examination (viva-voce), conducted for the purpose of selection. Those who pass the written test will be informed to attend the viva only through the OUSL website, SMS and Email.

The cut off mark for the selection of students for the particular academic year is determined by the department offering the degree programme and the list of selected students, based on a merit list, will be published in the OUSL website.

Orientation and Academic Counselling Sessions

Participation in the orientation session and ONE academic counselling session is compulsory. Applicants will need to produce **all relevant educational and professional certificates as instructed** (see information provided in next page).

During these sessions, you will be:

- provided with necessary guidance regarding the OUSL, ODL study system, selection of courses and filling the course registration form
- assigned an Academic Counsellor, who will guide you and certify the relevant educational/professional certificates, required for registration

It is **compulsory** to complete these activities before participating to the registration session assigned for you.

Registration Procedure

The selected students for registration will be informed individually and will be required to register for the Programme of Study on a specified date. It is very important that you register on the date specified. Registration after the scheduled registration period will NOT be permitted under any circumstances.

For all degree programmes, registration sessions for new students will be held at Regional Centres of the OUSL.

Documents required for Registration

When you come for Registration, you need to bring:

1. National Identity Card and a photocopy
2. Original Birth Certificate and a photocopy
3. Three passport size colour photographs (specifications given in registration calling letter)
4. G.C.E. A/Level and equivalent certificates and photocopies certified by your Academic Counsellor
5. G.C.E. O/Level certificate and photocopy certified by Academic Counsellor

G.C.E. (A/L & O/L) certificates: - You need to provide the original certificates which were issued by the Department of Examinations (other results sheets will not be accepted) and the photocopy signed by the Academic Counsellor.

6. Certificate of Professional Qualifications/Experience
BSc Hons in Nursing Programme - Diploma in Nursing Certificate or General Nursing Certificate, three year Diploma in Nursing certificate awarded by any other institution or, appointment letter to prove the required working experience where necessary and ALL photocopies of above proof, certified by Academic Counsellor.
BMLS Hons Programme - Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology, Ministry of Health, Sri Lanka and ALL photocopies of above proof certified by your Academic Counsellor.
BPharm Hons Programme - Certificate of Diploma in Pharmacy / Certificate of Proficiency in Pharmacy / Certificate of Efficiency in Pharmacy, and ALL photocopies of above proof certified by your Academic Counsellor.
7. Registration form countersigned by the Academic Counsellor (Forms will be given at the orientation and counselling session – get Counsellor’s signature before proceeding to registration desk)
8. University copy of the paid voucher
9. Declaration form

Registering for the Honours Degree Programme

The students are required to register for both Regular Courses and Continuing Education Courses offered for the Honours Degree programme. A student can register between 8 – 30 credits of courses depending on the time he/she has for studies.

Students who are selected but fail to register during the given time period **will not be able to register for the programme** on a later date. Therefore, new registrants are strongly advised to register on the due date or on the late- registration date scheduled for the programme.

Making Changes to Registered Courses

Students who are registered for courses, but wish to change the courses after the registration, are permitted to do so within the specified period known as the 'add/drop period' and 'drop only' period.

- (i) **Add Drop Period** - Registrants will be allowed to **add** or **drop** courses (make changes to registered courses) on the given dates. There will be no academic or financial penalty for such changes. The fees which you had already paid for the particular course will be deducted from your second instalment.
- (ii) **Drop Period** - Students will be allowed to **drop courses** on the scheduled Drop date, without any academic penalty. In this case, the fees (first instalment) which were already paid will NOT be refunded or carried over to the next academic year. However, such students will NOT be considered as repeat students when they register for the said courses in a subsequent academic year.
- (iii) Students who do not attend academic activities and give up courses after the scheduled drop date will be considered as **repeat students**, when they register for such courses in the next academic year. Students are not entitled to receive study materials for repeat courses as they have already received the material in the previous year. They will also not be eligible for any grade higher than a pass (C) in the repeat year.

Withdrawing from the Programme of Study After Registration

After registering in the Programme of Study for the first time, if your circumstances change and you wish to withdraw from the whole Programme, you can do so by writing to the SAR/Student Affairs and Welfare.

The last date to withdraw from the Programme with a refund of the tuition fee payments already made (after deducting a small percentage for administrative expenses) is the add-drop date.

Students dropping from the whole Programme of Study after this date will not get a refund. If such a student wishes to register for the Programme in a subsequent year, will have to apply and sit for the selection test again.

Registering for the StART@OUSL Programme

The Students' Academic Readiness Training at OUSL (StART@OUSL) is offered to all new students registering for undergraduate programmes offered by the OUSL. This is to facilitate students to develop their study skills to become independent learners in the ODL system of the OUSL. All new students registering for Degree Programmes at the Faculty of Health Sciences should register for LTE3412 and FDE3023. Those interested, can also select other StART@OUSL courses given under the optional category.

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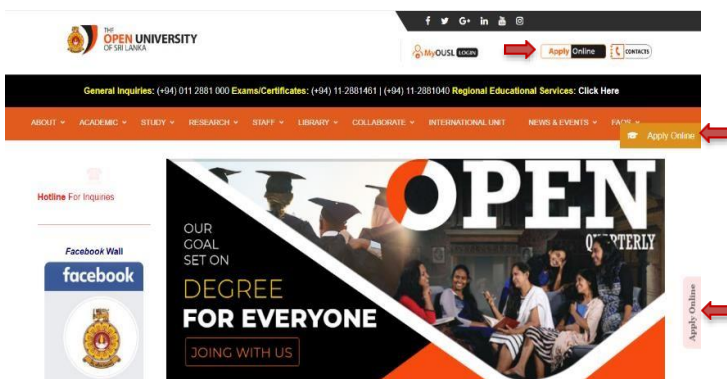
Appendix - 1

Instructions for ONLINE Application

APPLICATIONS for Honours Degree Programmes must be submitted ONLINE.

First you need to create an online login account. Then only, you can proceed to submit your application online.

1. In the internet browser type: www.ou.ac.lk/
2. In the OUSL homepage, click on the 'Apply Online' as shown below to obtain an **online account login**.



3. Register ONCE by creating a new account. To do this, click on 'create new account' as per the instructions (refer **a** and **b** below).

Note: You need to provide information considered as MANDATORY including an email address and a mobile number, both of which may be your own or of a family member/friend. The university may use them to communicate with you, to acknowledge receipt of your application and to provide additional information, when necessary.

4. Once the account has been created you can proceed to submit your application online. For this you need to go to "Online Application" and proceed by entering your username and password and then fill the

online application form (refer **c** below). Once all sections are filled, submit the form.

5. Select the payment method and proceed further by following the instructions given (refer **d** below). The Application Fee for all degree programmes is Rs.750/=. You can pay this amount by Credit/Debit card with online payment facility or eZ cash. Applicants can also make the respective payment by cash to any Regional or Study Centre of the OUSL before the application closing date.
6. Download the admission card for the selection test which will be generated for you after successful completion of the application process. Make a printout of the admission card as it is compulsory to produce at the selection test.

Check whether your Name, NIC No. and other details are accurately listed in the admission card.

Whom to contact if your online admission card could not be generated or had issues with making the payment online

If the admission card could not be generated or your payment could not be processed, contact the relevant AD/Regional Centre immediately (before attending the selection test) by using the contact details provided in Appendix 2.

Note: You cannot sit the Selection test without a valid admission card, with your details accurately listed. Therefore, it is your responsibility to check all information in advance, and rectify, if necessary, to avoid disappointments.
