## Important guidelines for self-registration

## **Bachelor of Science Honours in Psychology Degree Programme**

- This is a short guide for selecting courses without academic counseling. If you are competent in selecting the courses and if you are conversant with the system, you can complete your re-registration without academic counseling according to the instructions given in this guide.
- Please note that the student is the responsible person for his/her own course selection. The Department of
  Psychology and Counselling will not take any responsibility in your individual course selection.
- Take a printed copy of your recently downloaded (from MyOUSL) RESULT HISTORY/SHEET.
- The following is available in your **RESULT HISTORY/ SHEET**,
  - **Resit** Students who are eligible but failed to obtain a minimum pass mark at the Final Examination.
    - Resit candidates need NOT re-register for the course at the subsequent registration.
  - Repeat
- Students failing to obtain eligibility to sit the Final Examination for a course.
   Repeat students have tore-register for the relevant course in a subsequent year by re-paying the tuition fee.
- Students who obtained eligibility but failed at the final examination in both attempts provided.
- **Pending -**Final examination results are not released yet for the course. You can select such courses duringAdd/drop period if necessary.
- First step is to check your current progress. Carefully check your results sheet and mark already completed courses in the table (TABLE 01) given. Then, identify the courses and mark the courses you need to register for this academic year in the last column. Please consider the following when you select courses.
  - To complete Bachelor of Science (Hons) in Psychology degree programme, you must complete a total of 120 credits from level 3,4, 5, and 6. It consists of 30 credits from level 3, 30 credits from level 4, 30 credits from level 5, and 30 credits from level 6.
- You can decide the number of credits you want to register for this academic year up to a maximum of 30 credits, based on your capacity and time available for studies.
- You are strongly advised to balance your credits between two semesters when selecting courses. Check the semester that offers each course given in Table 01.
- Finally, mark the courses you wish to register for this academic year with an 'X' in the first blank column of the **Re-registration Form (Without academic counselling)** and place your signature by agreeing that you take the responsibility of your own course selection.
- If you have **not** completed the continuing education compulsory courses you are advised to register and complete the particular courses within this academic year (2023/24).
