Online support

- This course is supported by the Moodle Online Course. The online facility provides course information, learning resources, such as videos, MCQs, CAT and Final exam papers, and practical reservation.

Practical Sessions

In the practical class, you will be assessed based on online group presentations on related topics of mammals. The practical session includes two days. Practical group reservation will be done only via learnousl. Based on your preference you can form a group and select the practical group convenient to you and a group mammal that you like to prepare the presentations. On the first day will be informed how group work is going to conduct and on the next day (Friday) you will have to present your group work via zoom platform. Attendance on both days of the practical session is compulsory. Please log into the online course to check your group number and presentation topic before you come for practical sessions.

Practical reservation

- Practical group reservation is only possible via online reservation. Communicate with your friends and form a group before you select a practical group. You cannot change your group once you log into one group without informing the senior coordinator.
- Only those who have signed up for the particular group will not be admitted to the presentation sessions.

Exemption from attending practical sessions

A student who has obtained a Practical Assessment Mark of 30% or more, but fails to obtain eligibility to sit the final examination, may seek exemption from attending the practical session of the <u>succeeding academic year only</u>. You will be <u>exempted only if you obtain approval</u> to do so by requesting **in writing** to the Senior Coordinator. When granted such an exemption, the practical marks obtained in the previous year will be taken for computing the CAM.

Assessment & Evaluation of the Course

Continuous Assessment Tests

- This course has 2 No Book Tests (NBT), each of one-hour duration. Refer to the Zoology Activity schedule/CA schedule for the dates and times. The study material covered in each test and the nature of the test (MCQ/Structured, etc.) is indicated in the Table given earlier.
- Online assessmentIn addition to NBTs, there will be an online test which contributes to the practical mark.

Eligibility to sit the final examination

- Continuous Assessment Mark (OCAM) is computed on the two NBTs and the Practical Assessment Test as follows:
- OCAM = 50% of the best NBT + 20% of the other NBT + 30% of the Practical Assessment Mark (PAM)
 - **To be eligible to sit the final examination**, you must satisfy **<u>all three criteria</u>** below:
 - Attendance on all days of the practical session. PAM should be 30% or more.
 - > OCAM should be 35% or more.

Final Examination

- Final examinations, based on all units, will be held at end of 2nd semester and will consist of an Essay type question paper of 2 hours duration with 4 out of 6 questions to be answered.
- The Overall Mark (OVM) will be computed based on both the CAM and Final Examination Mark. Refer to the Faculty Prospectus for details on the computation of OVM and final grades.

ZooNet Award for ZYU5307 will be awarded to the student who scores **the highest Overall Mark and an A Grade** at the Final Exam (provided final exam was sat in year of obtaining eligibility).
