



Entry Requirements

Candidates should meet one of the following criteria:

- A degree from a recognized university with at least one year of work experience preferably in planning, administration, or implementation of development projects, or
- An equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Senate of the Open University of Sri Lanka with at least one year of relevant work experience, and
- Selection through an interview conducted by the Department of Social Studies, as needed.

Master of Arts in Development Studies and Public Policy

This is a programme of minimum two years duration. This programme offers you knowledge and research skills from a multi-disciplinary approach to development.

Drawing on the academic and professional experience and expertise of our faculty, the MA in Development Studies and Public Policy offers you a unique post-graduate study programme with a policy focus.

Programme Structure

Regular Courses: 45 credits. The courses are from the core social science disciplines of economics, politics, sociology and mass communication.

Research Work: 15 credits

Continuing Education Courses: 3 credits

The two academic years are divided into four semesters
