## ***Master of Laws in Criminal Justice Administration (LL.M.)***

### **Introduction**

The Master of Laws (LL.M.) in Criminal Justice Administration programme of the Open University of Sri Lanka has been designed by an eminent group of experts in the field after a thorough and careful study of the country's criminal justice system. Its design, content and expected outcomes not only address current and future needs but also reflect the emerging trends in the field of criminal justice administration. Being the first postgraduate degree programme in law in Sri Lanka approved by the Quality Assurance & Accreditation Council of the UGC (University Grants Commission) this pioneering programme will not only fill a long-standing lacuna in the country's higher education system but also facilitate the professional aspirations of many who are connected with or have an interest in the administration of criminal justice.

### **The Open University of Sri Lanka**

The Open University of Sri Lanka (OUSL) is a unique and prestigious institute of higher learning established under the provisions of the Universities Act No. 16 of 1978. It is the only national university in Sri Lanka that provides opportunities for life-long learning removing barriers that restrict access to tertiary level education. Using the open and distance learning (ODL) methods and equipped with sophisticated online facilities, OUSL currently serves over 40,000 students. They follow study programmes ranging from certificate or pre-degree programmes through first degrees to postgraduate qualifications offered by six faculties viz., Faculty of Humanities & Social Sciences, Faculty of Education, Faculty of Engineering Technology, Faculty of Natural Sciences, Faculty of Health Sciences and Faculty of Management Studies. It has a well-connected and coordinated network of nine regional centers and study centers in all administrative districts of the country. A large majority of OUSL students are working adults. The quality assurance of OUSL study programmes, including its teaching, learning and assessment processes at the peripheral centers, are constantly monitored by both internal and external experts to ensure that those programmes and processes comply with the national quality benchmarks.

### **The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences**

This is the largest Faculty of OUSL in terms of learner numbers. Currently it has over 13,000 students enrolled in four academic Departments i.e., Department of Legal Studies, Department of Language Studies, Department of Social Studies and Department of English Language Teaching. The Master of Laws in Criminal Justice Administration programme is conducted by the Department of Legal Studies subject to overall academic and administrative direction and supervision of the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, the Senate, and the University Council.

## Department of Legal Studies

The Department of Legal Studies has over 40 years of experience in conducting degree level programmes in legal studies. Established in 1984, our LL.B. degree programme is the most popular undergraduate law programme except the law degree programmes offered by conventional universities in the country. There are over 20 well qualified academic staff members serving full-time in the Department. These staff members have extensive experience in open and distance learning methodology and are highly concerned with the diverse needs of adult learners. In addition to internal staff, the Department obtains the services of a panel of experts drawn from various state- sector tertiary level academic institutes, departments, as well as practitioners etc. LL.M. programme is the first-ever postgraduate programme of the Department and the overall responsibility in the delivery activities of the programme is managed by the Department.

### The Master of Laws in Criminal Justice Administration Program (LL.M.)

This post-graduate programme is conducted by using the principles of ODL methods. This flexible student-centered approach creates an environment for professionals and others with increasing commitments to continue their advanced studies while fulfilling the professional demands and responsibilities of personal life.

This programme consists of 45 credits of coursework and 15 credits of research dissertation. The total of 60 credits is spread over in 13 subjects of law, science, and technology. The total duration is two academic years. However, maximum allowable period that a student can remain in the programme is six years after which the studentship lapses automatically. The unique intrinsic nature of this programme is that it is a multidisciplinary graduate programme which combines legal discipline with science and technology subjects. The structure, content and assessment method of each course designed in such a way that it enhances the knowledge and professional experience of candidates. At the end of the programme the candidates will be transformed into a well-equipped group of professionals with exceptional skills, knowledge and attitude who would add value to the jobs they perform.

### Dissertation

Dissertation is the research component of the LL.M. Degree Programme. Students are required to write a dissertation of 20,000 - 25,000 words. This dissertation is intended to work as a platform that facilitates the interface between theory and practice. The candidates have the freedom to select an area of their choice that is within the programme curriculum and engage in research under the guidance of an academic supervisor. The dissertation prepared at the end of the research will provide the candidates an opportunity to demonstrate a wide spectrum of academic and professional skills such as analytical skills, problem solving and presentation skills etc.

### Quality Assurance

The quality assurance is conducted by using the benchmark established in line with the international standards. Also, as a first step towards achieving quality assurance the UGC Quality Assurance and Accreditation Council has already approved this programme.

### Teaching and Assessment Method

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The teaching and assessment methods are in line with well- established open and distance learning (ODL) methods. There are a limited number of face-to-face teaching sessions that are usually held at weekends at Central Campus, Nawala. The dates, times and names of lecturers conducting these teaching sessions will be informed to you at the time of enrolment. The number of teaching sessions of the course depends on the credit weightage of each course. In addition, there may be seminars, field visits and practical demonstrations depending on the nature of the course content.

The assessment of students' performance at each course is conducted by using ODL assessment methods such as Continuous Assessment Tests (CATs), Tutor Marked Assignments (TMAs), submission of dissertations and final examinations etc.

### Entry Qualifications

A person having one of the following qualifications will be considered for registration for the Master of Laws in Criminal Justice Administration Programme.

- A degree in law from a recognized university  
or
- Attorney at Law of the Supreme Court of Sri Lanka with three (3) year's post qualifying professional experience  
or
- Have an equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Senate of the Open University of Sri Lanka.

## **Programme Duration**

The duration of the programme is two academic years. However, the maximum period allowed for a student to continue studies is six (6) years. Therefore, any registered student is required to complete his or her studies within maximum six years from the date of registration.

## **Medium of Instruction**

The medium of instruction, teaching and assessment of this programme is in English.

## **Fees**

Total fee for the programme is Rs.546,000.00. This is payable in four installments over a period of two years.
