Students who are presently employed or who were employed in the tourism industry need to show proof as fulfillment of the practical requirement.

A certificate of participation will be awarded to students who successfully complete attendance at online theory classes and the practical component

Course fee

Rs.12,000 to be paid in full at registration.

Course Description

This is a short course conducted online. The Learning Management System (LMS) called MOODLE will be used to deliver the entire course using the learnousl platform. Lesson materials and assignments will be posted on learnousl and students can respond also through the same medium. Instead of day schools, we will conduct meetings and lectures online using ZOOM. Students need not visit the Open University to follow lectures. While there are several advantages in this system, the biggest advantage is that students from any part of the country can participate without having to visit the University.
