## The Tourist Industry

One of the special characteristics of the Tourism Industry is its ability to show resilience in the face of any crisis. It has been estimated that the tourism industry in Sri Lanka would require over 200,000 persons directly and a further 300,000 indirectly to service the needs of the visitors to the country. Added to this, is the demand created by the intensified activities in the emerging tourist destinations in Asia and the Middle East resulting in a continuous drain of trained staff to other countries.

# **Course Description**

This is a short course conducted online. The Learning Management System (LMS) called MOODLE will be used to deliver the entire course using the learnousl platform. Lesson materials and assignments will be posted on learnousl and students can respond also through the same medium. Instead of day schools, we will conduct meetings and lectures online using ZOOM. Students need not visit the University to follow lectures. While there are several advantages in this system, the biggest advantage is that students from any part of the country can participate without having to visit the University.

For the practical component, students should work in a tourism related establishment for at least 21 days. Students who are presently employed or who were employed in the tourism industry need to show proof as fulfillment of the practical requirement.
