1. Be eligible for selection based on the Selection Test and Viva Voce marks,

AND,

2. Obtain a minimum three (03) Pass grades in one sitting at the G.C.E. A/Level Examination, in any stream of study, or C grades or equivalent in 60 credits at Levels 1 and 2 from among the Foundation Courses of the OUSL in Science/Social Sciences,

AND,

3. Minimum Simple Pass (S) for English at the G.C.E. Ordinary Level Examination, Sri Lanka OR.

4. An equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Senate

Those who fulfil the above admission criteria are required to participate in the Orientation Programme conducted by the faculty. **Documents to be arranged before the academic counselling are given in the Annexure 01.** The academic counselling sessions will be held on the same day after the orientation programme.

It is compulsory to wearing masks according to the Health Guidelines in the OUSL.

- The photographs should be printed on high-quality paper with no dots or ink marks
  Facial posture should not be changed
- **I** No spectacles are allowed for the photograph
- 4. G.C.E. O/L certificate and a scanned copy (issued by the Department of Examinations)
- 5. G.C.E. A/L (or equivalent) certificate and a scanned copy (issued by the Department of Examinations)

### PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING GUIDE FOR THE PROGRAMME REGISTRATION PROCESS:

STEP 1	At the Academic Counselling Session, you will be guided on how to complete the registration by the academic staff of the Department. <b>Attendance is compulsory for theAcademic Counselling Session.</b>
STEP 2	Your payment voucher (1 <sup>st</sup> Installment-60% of full payment) will be generated at the end of the Academic Counselling Session and will be directed to the online payment portal
STEP 3	Validation of Registration is the final step of this process, and you will be required to physically come to the University to produce ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES OF QUALIFICATIONS and to receive OUSL Student Record Book and Student Identity Card
