Re-registration and Commencement of Academic Activities

The Faculty of Engineering Technology has planned to conduct the re-registration related activities during the following dates:

Re-registration:

- Re-registration for BTech Hons (Eng) & BIS Hons programmes -
 - **3, 4, 9, 10 May 2023 (all RCs/SCs)**
 - **8 May 2023 (CRC only)**
- Re-registration for BSE Hons programme - **3, 4 May 2023 (all RCs/SCs)**

Late Re-registration:

- Late registration (All programmes) - **11, 12 May 2023 (all RCs/SCs)**

Add-drop:

- Add/Drop dates (All programmes) - **30, 31 May, 1, 2 June 2023**
- Late date to add Industrial Training courses - **28 July 2023 (all RCs/SCs)**

Drop:

- Drop dates (All programmes)- **27, 28 July 2023 (all RCs/SCs)**

Your payment voucher will be ready to download a few days prior to the commencement of the re-registration. This will be informed via **SMS and Email**. Kindly note that you are required to pay the **1st instalment prior to the re-registration.** Your date of re-registration will be informed to you through email. However, if the date allocated to you for the re-registration is after the commencement of the Academic Activities (06-05-2023), you are able to follow the scheduled activities for the courses that you wish to register through “FET2023 Faculty Class for Engineering Technology Students”. Details are given in the section - Commencement of the Academic Activities.

All the relevant details for the re-registration are available in the re-registration guidebook for academic year 2022-23, which you could download from the faculty webpage in due course.

Special Concessions for the Academic Year 2022-23

The Faculty of Engineering Technology has decided to award **Higher Diplomas and Degrees under both Interim and Revised curricula during the academic year 2022-23.**

The Faculty of Engineering Technology has decided to grant the following concessions to facilitate students planning to complete all academic requirements for the award of Degree under the Interim Curriculum, during the academic year 2022-23 and the terms and conditions are as follows:

1. A student who **could not complete the degree, under the Interim Curriculum (IC) for the academic year 2021-22, due to the lapse of eligibility, based on the results of the final examination of the same academic year may request an additional attempt to sit the final examination of the relevant IC courses during Academic year 2022-23.** The departments will offer the Final Examinations for the requested L5, L6 and a few other selected IC courses where the final examination was held during 2021-22. This additional attempt is not granted for the RC courses.

2. A student who has completed the final year project and the industrial training modules qualifies for the concession described in no 1 above. This concession will only be granted during the academic year 2022-23. Only those students who apply will be considered for this concession.
3. If the student has already registered for the mapping course(s) under RC, he/she must choose between the mapping IC and the RC course(s) to sit the final examination. (It should be noted that the final examinations of such mapped courses will be scheduled during the same time slots).
4. When a student passes an IC course under this concession, he/she is entitled to a **C grade** only.
5. The Assistant Registrar of the Faculty of Engineering Technology will inform all students via the faculty website and MyOUSL, requesting students qualifying for the above concession to apply during the stipulated period. The student shall make a request to the AR/FET, via a Google Form, stating the relevant course(s) he/she wishes to consider under this concession and the preferred centre.

Commencement of the Academic Activities

The Faculty of Engineering Technology plans to **commence regular academic activities from 06 May .2023**. You will be provided access to the **“FET2023 Faculty Class for Engineering Technology Students”** hosted in the **learnou.sl.ac.lk LMS**.

You may download the Course Materials for the courses you plan to enrol and commence your academic activities. All teacher-learner communication will be made through the above Faculty Class, until the LMS access to each course is made after completing the re-registration.

The **Activity Diary for Academic year 2022/23** will also be posted to the faculty webpage and to the above Faculty Class, prior to the commencement of re-registration.
