INSTRUCTIONS:

1. ALL STUDENTS OF BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (HONOURS) IN PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAMME IN THE FACULTY OF HEALTH SCIENCES ARE REQUIRED TO REGISTER FOR THE COURSES IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR OF 2025/26.
2. DATES FOR RE-REGISTRATION, LATE REGISTRATION, ADD/DROP AND DROP ARE GIVEN IN ANNEXURE 1.
3. TO SELECT COURSES OF THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (HONOURS) IN PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAMME YEAR 2025/2026, USE THE RE-REGISTRATION FORM GIVEN IN ANNEXURE 2.
 - Courses you wish to register for this academic year should be indicated with an 'X' in the first blank column of the Re-registration Form. You can decide the number of credits you want to register for this academic year up to a maximum of 30 credits, based on your capacity and time availability for studies.
4. IF YOU ARE A STUDENT WHO HAS REGISTERED THE FIRST TIME FOR THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (HONOURS) IN PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAMME IN THE PREVIOUS ACADEMIC YEAR AND HAVE **NOT** COMPLETED THE DUE COURSES IN THE StART@OUSL PROGRAMME, YOU ARE ADVISED TO REGISTER AND COMPLETE THE PARTICULAR COURSES WITHIN THIS ACADEMIC YEAR.

It is compulsory to register and pass **English for Academic Purposes (EAP) Intermediate Level** and **FDE3023 Empowering for Independent Learning (EfIL)** in Academic year 2025/26. Please note that EAP course codes have been updated as of the academic year 2025/26.

Carefully go through the required qualifications for each level of the EAP Course. (ANNEXURE 3)

- **Intermediate Level (LTE34LI):** This is the **faculty's expected level**. If you have the necessary qualifications, you can register directly for the Intermediate Level (**LTE34LI**).
- **Elementary Level (LTE34LE):** If you do not meet the qualifications for the Intermediate Level, you must first register for the Elementary Level. After completing it, you can progress to the Intermediate Level in the next academic year.
- **Advanced Level (LTE34LA):** This is an optional course. If you meet the entry requirements, you may register for LTE34LA and receive a certificate from the Open University of Sri Lanka upon completion.

To verify your English language proficiency for the EAP course, please bring the relevant certificates for each above-mentioned level (G.C.E. O/L and G.C.E. A/L) on the day of registration.

5. AFTER YOUR COURSE CHOICES ARE ENTERED TO THE COMPUTER SYSTEM BY STAFF AT THE REGISTRATION BLOCK, **CHECK WHETHER THE COMPUTER-GENERATED PRINTOUT ACCURATELY LISTS ALL COURSES** THOSE YOU HAVE INCLUDED IN THE REGISTRATION FORM.

1st semester examinations 2025/26– apply between 17th February 2026 to 21st March 2026

2nd semester examinations 2025/26-apply between 18th August 2026 to 10th September 2026

Please be informed that the under-protest category is unavailable effective from the academic year (2023/2024). If you have not registered to sit final exams online, you will NOT be permitted to sit the examinations.

Special Notices for Students

Please follow the given instructions.

Regarding Re-registration Counselling

- Your attendance is compulsory for re-registration counseling and if your re-registration form is not signed by the relevant counselor, you are not permitted to re-register for courses.
- When you are attending for re-registration counselling session, it is **compulsory** to present a hard copy of your recently downloaded **RESULT HISTORY/ SHEET**.
- Annexure-2 and 3 **must** be printed separately.

Regarding eligibility (OCAM)

- **2022/2023 academic year onwards**, the eligibility (OCAM) for the courses of Bachelor of Science Honours in Psychology Degree Programme is valid only for **two years** including registered year and one subsequent year.

Re-registration at preferred Regional Centres

- On the re-registration day, students can re-register at their preferred regional centre. Thereafter, that regional centre is your examination centre for Continuous Assessment Tests (CATs) and Final examinations.

Regarding Centre Change

- If you need to change centre, send a request letter through Assistant Director of the preferred centre to the Senior Assistant Registrar (SAR), Student Affairs, OUSL.

Optional Courses (Level 5 and Level 6 only)

- For **Levels 5 and 6**, students are required to select one optional course per semester from two offered courses. You must choose only **one** optional course per semester.

Add/Drop date: **06th and 07th January 2026** at **All Regional Centres**.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (A) You are permitted to change courses by adding or dropping courses you previously registered for without any financial or academic penalty on Add/Drop date.
- (B) Check if the staff member has made the appropriate entry in the Student Registration Book.
- (C) Courses at a higher Level cannot be offered unless the minimum credit requirement specified is offered at the lower Level (for example, you cannot register for Level 6 courses, without having registration/exemption/EL for 30 credits at Level 5).
- (D) Courses at a lower Level cannot be dropped unless all courses offered at the higher Level are also dropped (for example, you cannot drop any Level 5 courses, unless you drop the courses registered at Level 6).
- (E) You are not allowed to add courses unless you have paid the full voucher sent to you without any changes. If you have got your voucher reduced, you cannot add courses based on additional fees paid.
- (F) Request for Add/Drop of courses will be entertained only **ONCE** per student.
- (G) **Add/Drop form is available for download in the Department website.** Students must fill sections 1 to 4 in the form and hand over the completed form to the Academic Counsellor.

DROPPING OF COURSES WITHOUT ACADEMIC PENALTY

Drop date: **06th February 2026** at **Colombo Regional Centre**.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (A) There will be no academic penalty for courses dropped up to 06th February 2026. However, the 1st instalment paid (60%), in respect of the courses you drop must be forfeited.
- (B) Courses CANNOT be dropped at a lower Level unless those offered at a higher Level are also dropped.
- (C) A request for dropping of courses will be entertained only **ONCE** per student.
- (D) **Drop form is available for download in the Department website.** Students must fill the form and hand over the completed form to the Head of Department.
- (E) Once the form is signed by the Head, it is your responsibility to take it to Registration Desk and have the dropped courses officially recorded in your Student Record Book and the Computer system.
